The Insurance Corporation Conservation Awards recognise those people who undertake projects that display their concern for the environment. The aim of the competition is to bring these efforts to the attention of others and, as a consequence, to highlight the important environmental conservation work that takes place throughout the Island of Jersey.



The competition encourages conservation projects, no matter how LARGE or small, and projects that are either finished or unfinished, emphasis being placed on nature conservation.

There are two sections:

**1. The Best Conservation Project** - £2,000 prize.

*This encourages entries from individuals, families, conservation and environmental groups or organisations, companies, landscaping firms, States departments and parishes.*

**2. The Best School Project** - £1,000 spread over three years.

*This gives schools the opportunity to increase the public awareness of their conservation projects created by the pupils as part of their school curriculum.*

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **The closing date for entries is Friday 15 June 2012.**
2. Completed entry forms are to be taken or sent to LR&D Limited, Cranwell House, Route du Picquerel, L'Islet, St Sampson's, Guernsey GY2 4SD or email to jim@LRandD.com.
3. Conservation projects of any size will be considered however, emphasis will be placed on nature conservation.
4. One entrant may submit any number of projects as long as each submission has a separate entry form.
5. A third party may nominate a project undertaken by another provided approval is sought beforehand.
6. The £2,000 prize money for the "Best Conservation Project" will be awarded on the understanding that it will be used for the further enhancement of the project or further nature conservation projects. The annual grant of £1,000 spread over three years for the ongoing maintenance of the winning "Best Schools Project" is subject to the winning school applying every year.
7. Projects that have been entered in the past can again be entered if further enhancement is evident, however, the school that receives first prize for the "Best School Project" is not allowed to enter the winning project into the competition whilst it is receiving the grant.
8. Judging will take place on Tuesday 26 June 2012.
9. The winners will be announced at a presentation on Thursday 5 July 2012.
